PERMISSIONS & GENERAL RELEASE

I/We give permission to Greater Green Bay Habitat for Humanity to check any and all information, including but not limited to home ownership history, criminal record, and sexual offender registry to determine eligibility for services. *Rock the Block is a program of Greater Green Bay Habitat for Humanity and Habitat is not allowed to provide services to any registered sex offenders.

I/We understand that Habitat may test for lead-based paint, and lead-based paint may be disturbed during projects. Habitat is unable to knowingly disturb lead painted material, so pressure washing, home repair and painting projects may be denied upon confirmation of lead-based paint. Habitat may discuss concerns related to lead-based paint during the assessment process and may deny project requests or discuss alternative options for lead remediation prior to any renovations. Habitat assumes the cost of any necessary lead testing and shares test results with homeowners. Resources for lead remediation will be discussed if applicable.

I/We understand that Rock the Block projects are completed in part by paid Habitat staff members and volunteers. Some projects are completed by contracted professionals. All approved projects are completed at no cost to homeowners. Habitat does not assume responsibility for ongoing maintenance or repairs beyond the scope of work determined before projects commence.

Furthermore, I/we understand the completion of this application does not guarantee that I/we will receive services. Greater Green Bay Habitat for Humanity cannot guarantee work to be done, or guarantee completion of any projects discussed during assessment appointments. All plans are subject to re-evaluation or cancellation at any time due to unforeseen circumstances including but not limited to structural problems (wood rot, insect infestation, program funding, volunteer availability, inclement weather, permit limitations, etc.).

The scope of work is limited to the mutually agreed-upon repairs signed off by the homeowner. **No additional project requests will be accepted or completed after the initial agreement is signed.**

POTENTIAL PROJECT EXAMPLES

While we evaluate each home individually, common projects we may address include:

- **Landscaping & Yard Work:** Lawn edging, patching and seeding, weeding, raking, brush removal, mulching (standard natural mulch), and bush or tree trimming.
- **Tree Services:** Professional tree removal and stump grinding.
- **General Exterior Maintenance:** Pressure washing (up to 10 feet), gutter cleaning (debris removal only), and storm door repair or installation.
- **Major Exterior Repairs:** Siding repair or replacement, garage updates (service doors or overhead doors), fence repair, concrete repair or replacement, and porch work (treads or railings).
- **Accessibility:** Installation or repair of ramps, handrails, and accessible walkways.

Note: Greater Green Bay Habitat for Humanity cannot guarantee work or completion of any projects discussed; all plans are subject to re-evaluation due to funding, volunteer availability, weather, or permit limitations.
